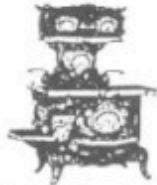
1. Which of these items might be used to entertain Mrs. Wolfe's boarders in the Parlor?

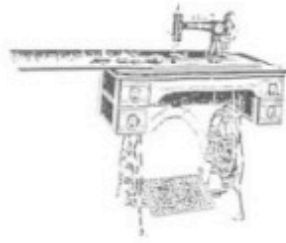
